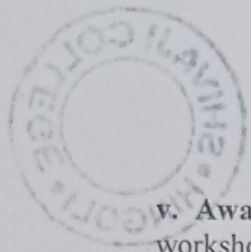
The key objectives of the OBC Cell in Shivaji College, Hingoli:







