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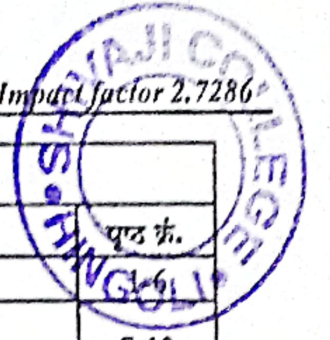
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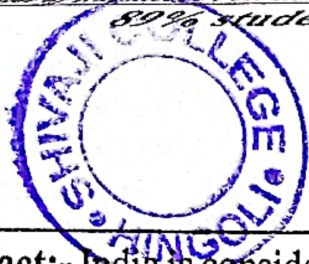

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
89% students fail writing exam numbers in lakh.
-An Empirical Study.

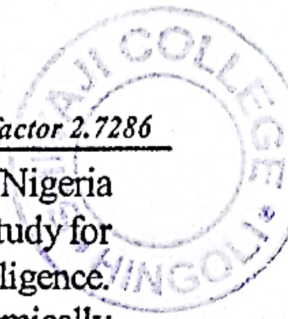
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Abstract:- India is considered to be a country of youth. These are the pillars of the future country. If India is to become a superpower, if the country is to become physically, mentally, socially, intellectually, morally and educationally capable, then the youth of that country must also be physically, mentally, financially, socially, intellectually and academically capable. Then our country can have overall development. The fact is that the physical, mental, intellectual and moral development of the youth is through education. But in the real sense, is today's education becoming as good as it should be? It is time for all of us to introspect. In those two-three years, the intellectual level of the students seems to have come down sharply. In this connection, a survey has been conducted based on actual experience in the context of college degree examinations. And the findings are very serious and dangerous. Objectives of this survey is 01) To create awareness in the college students, seriousness regarding examinations. 02) To make the students aware of the consequences of exam results on family members. 03) Reduce the student's negative mentality about examination and career. 04) To create awareness in the college students, not taking easiness of examinations and career. 5) To create awareness in the college students, remember the hard work of your father and mother behind your examinations and career. Findings from this survey are as follows. 1) 89% of college students cannot write numbers in lakh in exams. 02) Only 11% of college students can write numbers in lakh. 03) There is a difference between boys and girls when college students put their own number in lakh in the answer sheets. 04) College students are not able to put numbers in both Marathi and English. 05) College students show more negativity and depression in terms of career and exams. 06) Students were found to be more dependent on others for passing.

Introduction:- India is considered to be a country of youth. These are the pillars of the future country. In those two-three years, the intellectual level of the students seems to have come down sharply. In this connection, a survey has been conducted based on actual experience in the context of college degree examinations. And the findings are very serious and dangerous.


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According to Omemu (2015), students do not understand their self-concept in Nigeria any longer. This is as a result of parents or guardians who want to choose a course of study for their wards and not minding what that child is capable of doing in terms of ability and intelligence. If the parents choose a wrong course for their wards, they will probably not do well academically because that is not their area of interest. However, the parents will want their wards to pass that chosen course by all means. On the part of the wards, they will want to pass by all means so that they will not look as failures to their parent. This situation propels them into examination malpractices to satisfy the needs of their parents. This study therefore was conducted to review literature, identify some of the major causes of examination failure among the students of tertiary institutions in Nigeria.

The assertion of Itedjere (2006) is in line with previous findings by Okafor (1990), who blamed the society for Examination malpractice. According to him, in a country where dishonesty has been enshrined by the adult sector as an idol of worship, children have learnt to steal with impunity; examination malpractice in all shades and forms consequently becomes the order of the day among our students at all level of the educational arrangement. Hitherto, the reason why in Nigeria today, people value money more than any other thing thereby reminding one of a saying that "the end justifies the Means".

Elements of College students regarding examination

01) Students are not studying. What is the use of modern student education? They have a negative attitude towards exams and education. What they don't realize is that this development is happening through education. There is a common misconception among parents and students that education is all about getting a job. But they have completely forgotten that college knowledge is not used to get a job. So using this knowledge in real life is to live your life happily. Also, use this knowledge to develop your business, your farm, and your small and medium enterprises.

02) Students do not have the seriousness of the exam. Did you pass? And failed? It doesn't matter to most students. They will not go for exams on time, they will not see their exam numbers on the board, they will be wandering around, they will run away when the paper starts, most of them do not know their subjects, they will not leave home before the exam Without going, they go to the examination center after the paper the next day, many students

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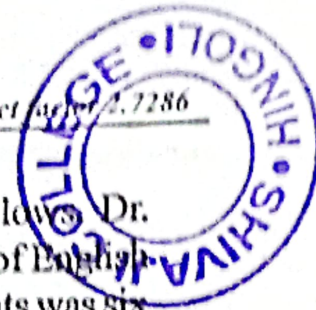


do not understand the schedule and do not even try to understand. Such is the condition of our students.

03) Many students depend on others to pass. There is a big misconception among students that just passing the exams means success. Only a degree, only passing is not really success, but the result of your exam depends on how you present your studies in the exam, how many questions you miss. Many students have the mentality that we can pass the exam by looking at others, Ask other friends in the class, if the friend did not tell the test, after the test will express anger at the friend, blame his own failure on the other, betray the trust of parents, money, time, wasted and nothing will be in hand. I.e. output zero. His expectation is that even if you are twenty-two or twenty-three years old, someone else should feed me with a spoon. He would have inculcated such a bad habit in himself. This is where the research came from. Then I told my close friends that while you were supervising, I asked them to compile a list of how many boys and girls in your class write their own exam numbers in letters and how many boys and girls do not write in letters (in lakes). And my friends and I made the collection.

Students Conflict:- Students Conflict is created in our minds. That is, they are responsible for every physical and mental struggle, the mental processes of each of them. Every student goes through a mental struggle. As a college student builds his career, the intensity of his struggle depends on how he looks at his career and the world around him. The factors responsible for the formation of conflict are as follows. Pain-Attention- Sensation, thought, motivation, emotion, and decision making process. 01) Sensation-Attention-Perception: - When students are pursuing their careers in the field of education, their struggle depends on how they penetrate the world through their five senses, that is, how much attention they pay to education, study and career while pursuing their careers. What in the world do they focus on and what do they not focus on? Also do we try to do anything 100% while studying? If they do, there won't be much conflict. 02) Negative Thinking: - Thoughts are mainly negative and positive. Conflicts are 100% created when college students look at studies and their careers from a negative point of view, but they do not do anything from a positive point of view. And then learning is of no use. This negative attitude leads to conflict. 03) Unrealistic needs: -Every person from birth to death is trying to meet the physical and mental needs. But there is no guarantee that all needs will be met. We are happy when our needs are met, and we are sad when our needs are not met. That is, conflict arises in the mind. Physical struggle accompanies mental struggle to meet those needs. Every student is trying to meet their mental needs through education. If we create unrealistic needs and try to meet them, they will definitely not be met and then conflict arises. The question arises as to whether education should be learned or not. 04) You don't have the capacity. Many students fail in life because they do not have that ability. When I do not have the ability to succeed in any field, if I pretend that I have them, then there will definitely be conflict in the future. Because while studying in college, time, money, age, physical and mental efforts are wasted. Then things like frustration, anxiety, frustration, suicide happen automatically.

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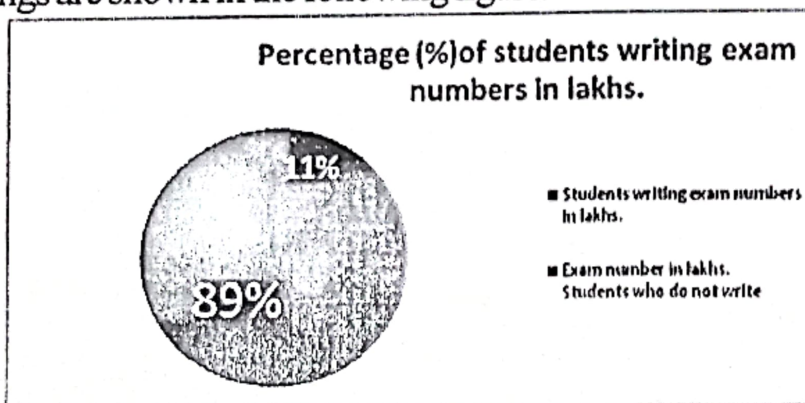
Data Collection:-


The collection of supervision provided by me and my friends was as follows. Dr. Nalge J. P. He supervised at Hall No. 5 on 08/02/2022 when he had 24 students of English Compulsory subject, Arts Department. The examination number of all the students was six digits. This means that students have to write numbers in numbers and letters in the exam. I wanted to write numbers in letters. Only 3 out of 24 children in their hall had written numbers in lakes. Of them, 02 were girls and 01 was boys, while the remaining 21 students wrote numbers like two, five, eight, three, and four seven. As like this, I was taken seven halls for this survey. In these seven halls, all students were 191 (one hundred ninety one). With male and female.

Result and Discussion:- Findings from this survey are as follows. 1) 89% of college students cannot write numbers in lakh in exams. 02) Only 11% of college students can write numbers in lakh. These findings are shown in the following figure.

07) Also this survey, support of N.G. Hayatu1* and B.B. Abubakar2, research topic on Causes of Examination Failure among the Students of Tertiary Institutions in Nigeria: A Review and his conclusions was, The literature reviewed so far has shown that the causes of students' failure in examinations are multi-dimensional in nature. In other words, solutions to the problems require collaborative efforts of the various stakeholders. However, causes such as absence of suitable study conditions at home and lack of social support and learned failure are said to result in failure. Therefore, emphasis should be shifted towards overcoming them

Limitations:-

- He figures and percentages of males and females have not been calculated by the college students while putting or writing in lakh on the answer sheets.
- Language statistics and percentage are not shown in this survey when college students enter the answer sheet in lakh.
- College students are not divided according to class while putting numbers in lakh on the answer sheet.
- While the college students are putting the marks in the answer sheets in lakh, the analysis has not been done according to the branch.

Recommendations:

- College students should be aware of career and exams.
- While college students are studying, students should keep in mind that their parents work hard to pay for their education.
- If you don't want conflict in your life, you should focus more on your career and exams.
- College students should be self-reliant and not dependent on others for exams.
- Students need to look at life from an optimistic point of view and not from a pessimistic point of view.
- College students should choose their career according to their own tastes, abilities, intelligence, personality and mental abilities.
